How your Province will win

Your province will earn points by outperforming the other nine Canadian jurisdictions in membership recruitment during the 2018-2019 fraternal year. In the months of July, August and June, your province will compete against the other nine provinces. September thru May, you'll compete against individual provinces in a round robin competition. And in all twelve months, you'll be able to earn bonus points for being on-pace to meet your Circle of Honor intake quota.

Maximum Points – 150 (20 each in July, August and June...10 in each of the other months)

On June 30, 2019, the jurisdiction with the most points wins the Canada Cup.

Here's how it works.

July, August and June - (Start Strong...Finish Strong)

Country-wide competition among all 10 provinces (maximum of 20 points available)
